91 million Americans live with arthritis & other rheumatic diseases, but until this year, there was only one federal research program dedicated to arthritis.

Arthritis is the:

#1 cause of disability in the United States.

#2 cause of medical discharge from the U.S. armed services (after battlefield wounds). It affects one-third of servicemembers. For veterans, it is even more prevalent and also the leading cause of disability.

Beneficiaries of rheumatology research include 60 million adults and 300,000 children with doctor-diagnosed arthritis in the United States.
